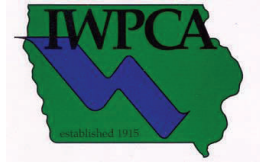

Getting Started

1. Read and follow all instructions carefully; complete all sections fully and accurately.
2. Exam Fee is \$45.00 and must accompany the application. Make check payable to Iowa Water Pollution Control Association.
3. Be sure to include a contact person and phone number of someone who will be able to verify experience and education required for the class of exam selected.

General Instructions

- ⇒ 1 Month of extra experience in collection system operations may be substituted for 1 month of post high school education, up to half of the post high school education requirement
- ⇒ Up to half of the experience requirement may be substituted with directly related post high school education.
- ⇒ Education or experience used to meet the basic requirements cannot also be used for substitution.
- ⇒ Two semester hours, or 3 quarter hours, or 3 CEU's that are directly related may be substituted for 6 months of experience for Class 1.
- ⇒ 1.25 semester hours, or 1.92 quarter hours, or 1.92 CEU's that are directly related may be substituted for 1 month of experience for Class II, Class III, or Class IV.
- ⇒ Directly related post high school education includes chemistry, biology, engineering, math, and wastewater courses.
- ⇒ One Year of post high school education equals 15 semester hours, or 23 quarter hours, or 23 CEU's
- ⇒ No substitution is allowed for the Class IV direct responsible charge experience requirement.
- ⇒ Experience in a related environmental control utility, in a related utility division, or in an allied trade (such as plumbing) may substitute for no more than 1/2 the required experience for any class
